 - Once you are here please call our office at 503-239-9663 to let us know you are here and what products you need. We will -come out and help you, with a minimum 6-foot buffer
 - Once you are loaded up please call us again so we can take payment over the phone for a NO CONTACT transaction. We can also email you a receipt.
- During this time, we have also adjusted our delivery requirements
 - **FREE DELIVERY in the PORTLAND METRO AREA (within 10 miles of our shop)**
 - REDUCED delivery fees for outside the 10 mile radius from our shop* Please call for details

If you do come to our lumberyard, please know that aside from the precautions listed above we are following the guidelines of the Center for Disease Control to help prevent the spread of this virus. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/about/prevention.html>

Our employees have been:

- Segregated to workstations that are a minimum of 10 feet apart or divided by a wall

- Wearing gloves when handling lumber and other products.
